Registration for the Fall Semester will begin in August. This summer the youngsters and JAM staff will deliver the blankets they made as their mission/outreach ministry, to folks currently living in local nursing homes. Afterwards they'll stop for some ice cream and fellowship! Now is the time to prayerfully consider what role you might take: For example, weekly possibilities include: Table Parent, Teacher, Greeter, Music Helper, Cooking Team Member. Another weekly opportunity would be setting up tables on Tuesday (not Wednesday the JAM evening). Other opportunities include providing financial support, commit to praying for the ministry, being a once a month visitor to show your support to the children (and for the fun and fellowship), being a substitute should one of the staff become ill or need to be away, or offer to be part of the clean-up crew once or twice a month (30 minute commitment or come for dinner first, then help clean-up and make it 60 minutes). We promise your heart will be filled to overflowing as you witness the making of disciples for Jesus!
